Keynote Speakers:



Jill Briscoe is an evangelical Christian author and international speaker. Jill was born in England and found Christ when she was 18 years old. She never looked back. Upon graduating from Cambridge University, she began working as a teacher by day and had a vigorous street ministry to the youths of Liverpool by night.

Jill met Stuart at a youth conference and they married in 1958. In the 50 years since, Jill has become a highly sought-after Bible teacher and author who travels the world ministering to under-resourced churches and speaking at international seminars and conferences. Since 2000, she and Stuart, who was formerly senior pastor of

Elmbrook Church for 30 years, have had the joy of equipping and encouraging believers across the globe in their roles as ministers-at-large for Elmbrook.

Jill has authored more than 40 books including devotionals, study guides, poetry and children's books. Her vivid, relational teaching style touches the emotions and stirs the heart.



Rhea Briscoe is driven by a passion to encourage and equip women to walk in the Freedom and power of who they are in Christ Jesus. Rhea's fervor is to see women Liberated by the truth of the Word of God and transformed by the Power of His Holy Spirit. She is first and foremost a lover of Christ, but is also a pastor's wife, mother of seven, a career woman, and an active keynote and conference speaker. Rhea draws from experiences of God's faithfulness in painful times and uses His Word to minister the love of Christ to others. Her zeal is contagious as she passionately ministers the life-giving truth of God's Word.



Esly Carvalho is a Brazilian-American clinical psychologist, EMDR Trainer, Psychodramatist, public speaker and the author of many books. Esly helped found Exodus Latinoamérica in 1994 in Quito, Ecuador and is currently its vice-president. She was one of the founding members of Exodus Global Alliance in 1995. She also founded EMDR Brasil. Esly is involved in the clinical aspects of recovery and healing including therapy that leads to changes in sexual orientation. She has published a book in Spanish called When the Homosexual Asks for Help. Having lived in many other countries of Latin America, she is fluent in English, Spanish and Portuguese. In 2006, Esly returned to her native Brazil and maintains a private

practice in Brasilia, the capital of the country. She has re-connected with the rich and extensive Psychodrama community in her country but continues to network and train internationally.



Pastor Bill Lenz is the founding and senior pastor of Christ The Rock Community Church (CTRCC) in Menasha, Wisconsin. Following a dramatic conversion to Christ in 1975 in the midst of rebellion, drug & alcohol abuse, God birthed a desire in Bill's heart to reach lost and hurting individuals through a ministry of street evangelism, including a 24-hour hotline, counseling center, youth outreach and concerts. The need to start a church became evident as many were coming to Christ and needed to be discipled. *Christ The Rock* church has grown exponentially, mostly through conversion and over 100 ministries are now offered.

Bill has a passion for world missions and training pastors and has traveled in the past few years to Mexico, Eastern Europe, Haiti, India, Israel, Sierra Leone, Rwanda, Sudan, Egypt and Jordan.
