Look at a specific case study and encourage discussion regarding other cases 5. Christian model to work with clients who have experienced sexual trauma and the complex trauma of Human Trafficking. This model is consistent with the current Dissociative Structural Model and with the guidelines for the treatment as established by the International Society for the Study of Trauma and Dissociation.
